Instructions

- Printer
- x5 A4 sheets of card (100gsm or higher)
- String, ribbon or raffia
- Glue OR sticky tape
- Hole punch
- Scissors



Learn how to cut and fold this fantastic star box!

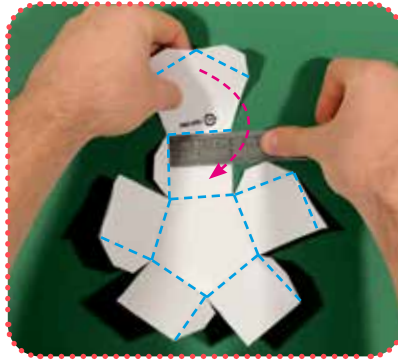
What will you put in your Christmas box?

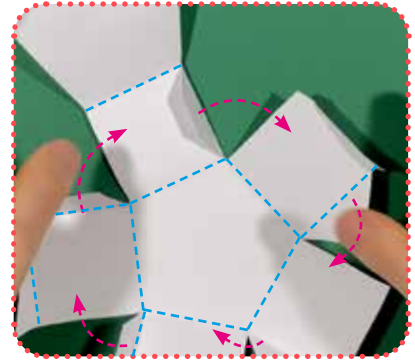
1. Print the template and cut out the middle pentagon and the five points.



2. Fold along all the dotted lines. (Using a ruler may help with folding).



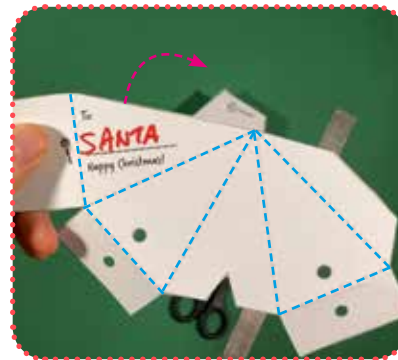
3. Carefully glue the tabs to create the pentagon. Tape can also be used.



4. Fold these tabs over and punch holes through the circle targets.



5. Write a name of your choice on the label. Fold along lines and glue tabs.



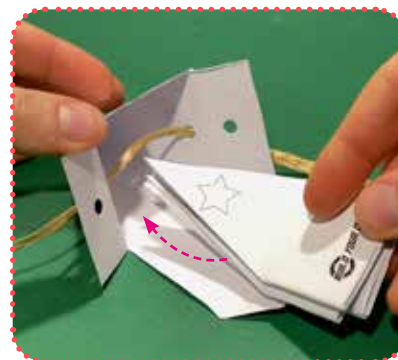
6. Repeat this process for all the other four points.



7. Cut 60cm of string and carefully tie through all of holes inside the points

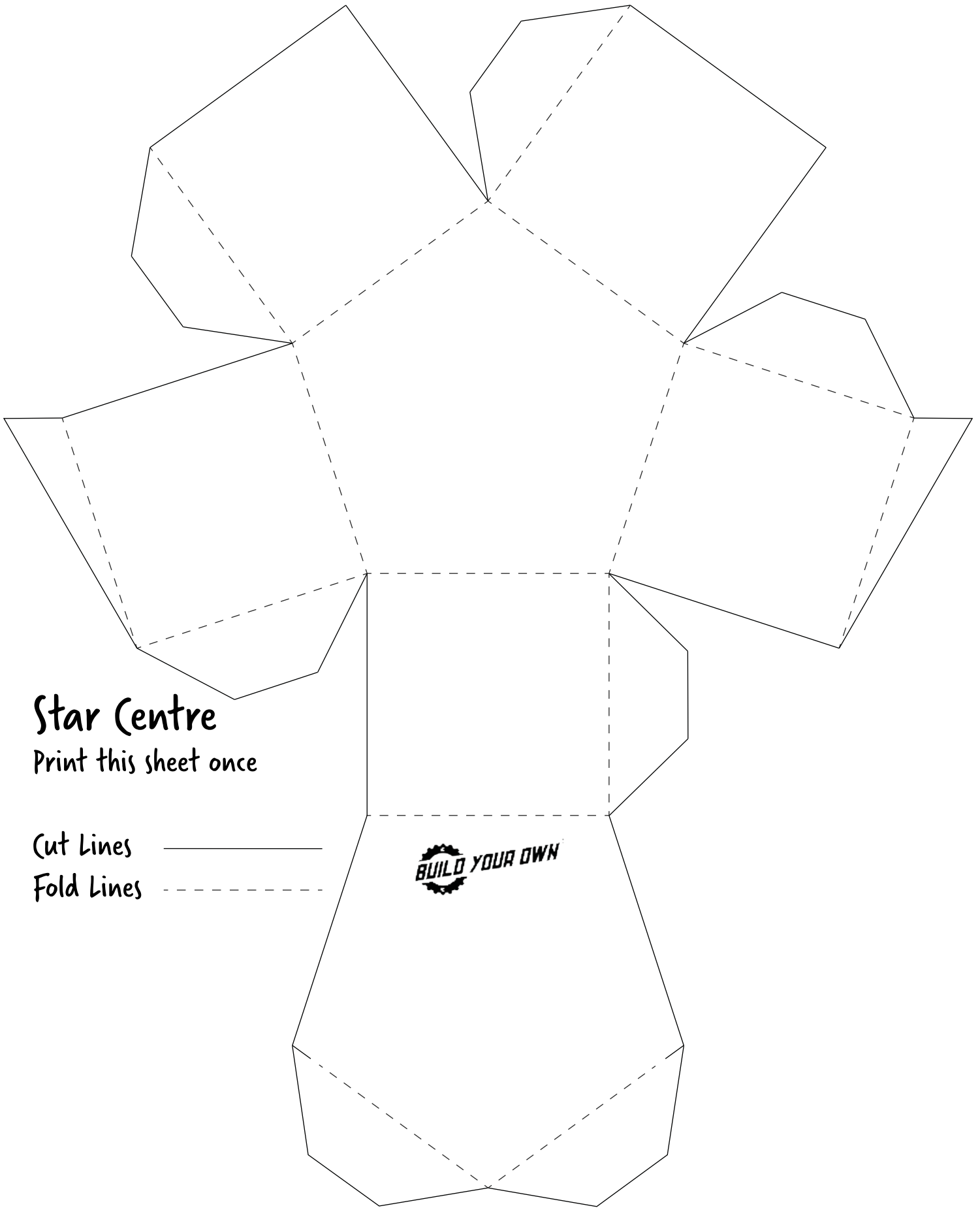


8. Create and customise the crown at the end of this template to place inside.



9. Wrap the string of points around the pentagon. Add string as a hanger too.

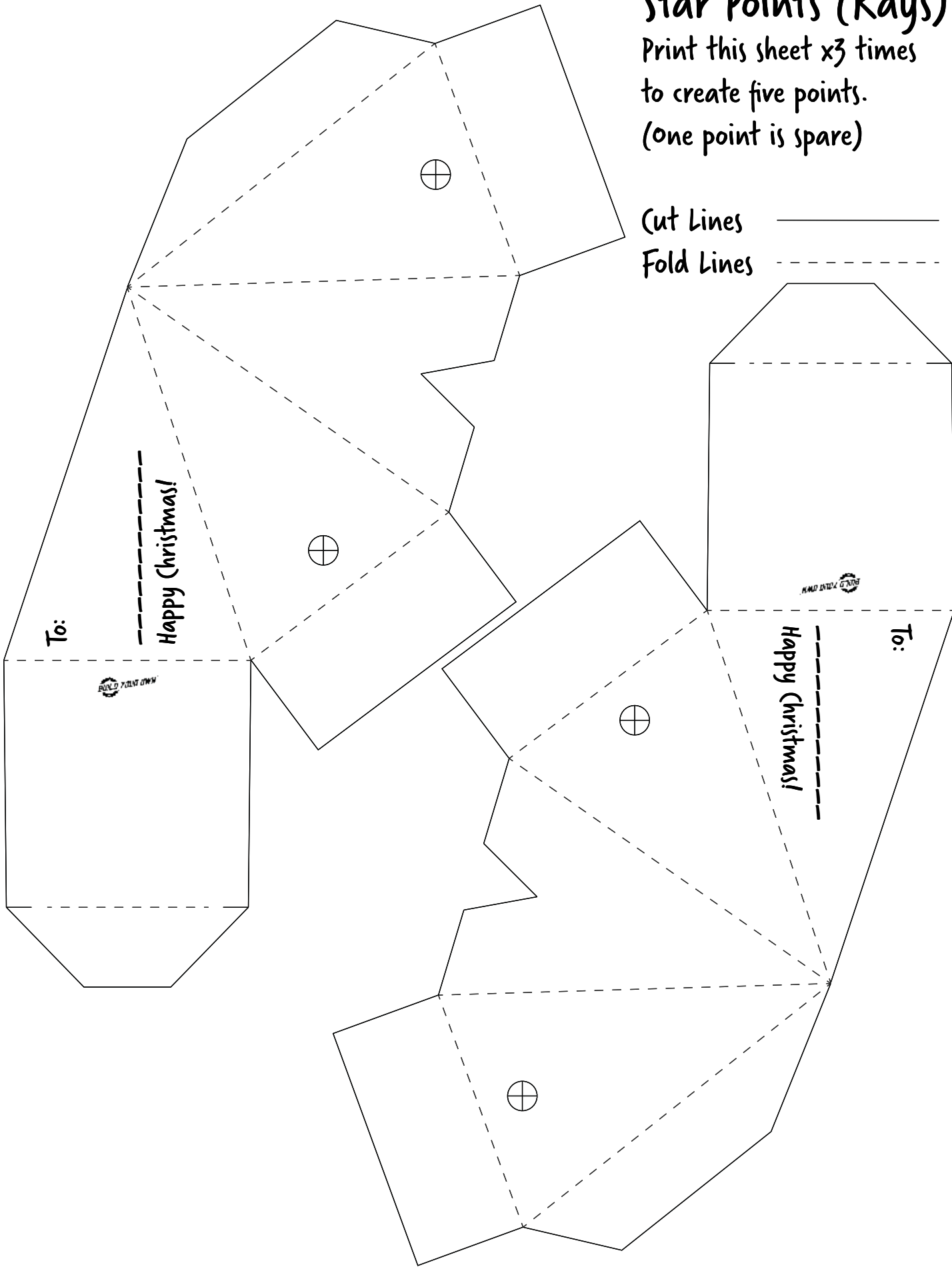

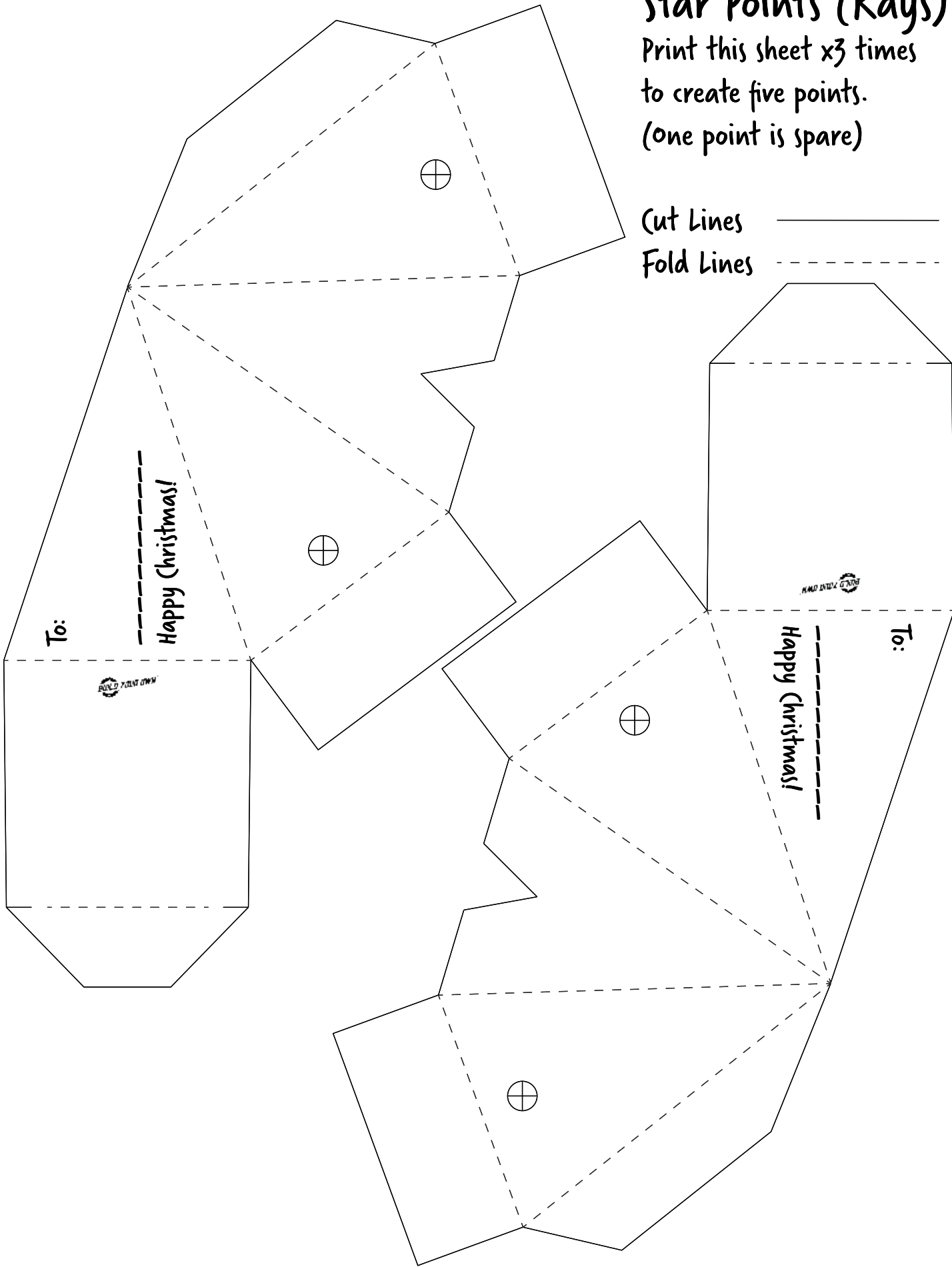

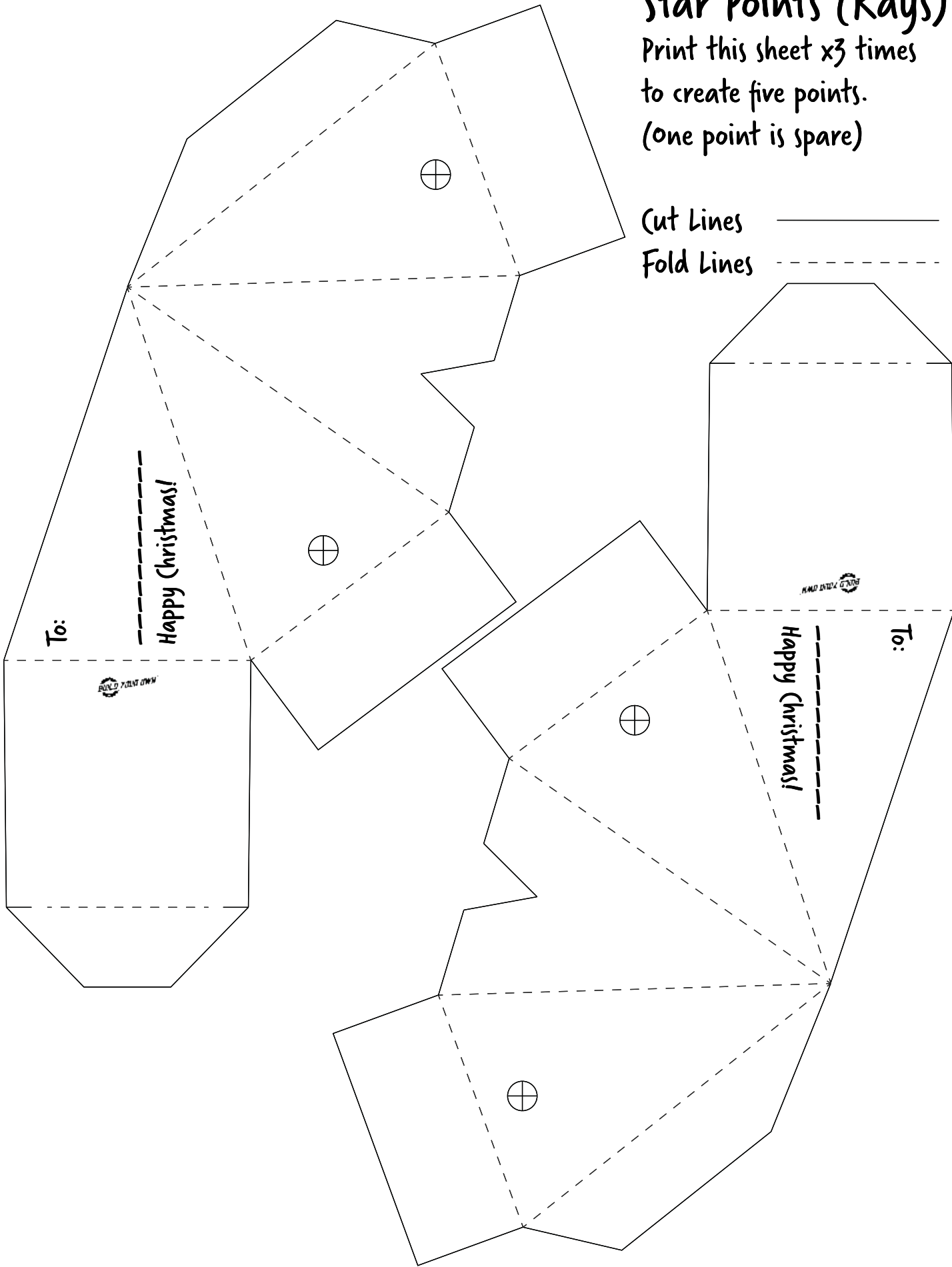
